- **Activities related to standards:**
 - The DoW of EELA-2 plans set the interoperability between gLite and the middleware of the OurGrid project (www.ourgrid.org)
→ a close monitoring of the GIN task force at OGF and similar working groups will be performed;
 - We are also interested in a common authorization scheme for interoperable middleware and in the co-existence of different middleware on the same physical resources.
- **Plans for concertation with other projects:**
 - During the first phase of EELA several MoUs/joint events were established/organized with other FP6 project;
 - In the second phase, instead of establishing “peer to peer” MoUs, we would like to launch the idea of a “club of projects” for the adoption of standards, sharing of policies and implementation of best practices for dependable and sustainable e-Infrastructures in the various regions of the world → the idea will be presented at a Concertation Workshop proposed to be held at EGEE’08.
